State Agency Updates

I'd like to start off by telling you all how much we appreciate the hard work you are doing across Alaska, I'm not sure any of us predicted where we would be this fall. We know that Alaskan schools are facing staff shortages and food cancellations and delays like we've never seen before. Please know that we are here to help support you in problem-solving issues. USDA has issued many waivers to support the flexibilities that school districts may need. USDA has issued more than one hundred waiver memos, so if you are trying to track one down, please see their COVID response page at <u>https://www.fns.usda.gov/fns-disasterassistance/fns-responds-covid-19/child-nutrition-covid-19-waivers</u>.

Another resource available for you is the Wednesday roundtable we hold to discuss waivers, regulation changes, and other issues impacting school nutrition. It is a great opportunity to talk to peers from across the state.

October is coming, and this is a reminder that all schools and residential child care intuitions must complete the verification report, even if they do not traditionally receive applications for free or reduced-price meals.


